(February 10, 2025) – The West Shore Parks & Recreation Society (WSPR) has begun a process to better understand needs for recreation and sport facilities in the Westshore through the development of a Facilities Master Plan. WSPR operates several indoor and outdoor recreation and sport facilities on behalf of its municipal partners. The municipal partners include the City of Langford, City of Colwood, Town of View Royal, District of Metchosin, and District of Highlands. Collectively, these municipalities form the study area for the master plan.
