

PART 3 REMOVAL OF VEHICLES, CHATTELS, SNOW SIGNS, AND RUBBISH

8. Removal of Vehicle

Where any vehicle is unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or public place, a Peace officer or a person authorized by the chief administrative officer may:

- (1) move the vehicle or require the driver or person in charge of the vehicle to move it to a position determined by the Peace Officer or authorized person; or
- (2) move the vehicle or take the vehicle into his custody and cause it to be taken and stored in a safe and otherwise suitable place.

9. Removal of Chattel or Obstructions

Any chattel or obstruction unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or public place may be removed, detained, or impounded by any person authorized to do so by the Chief administrative officer or a Peace Officer.

9.1 Political Campaign Signs

Political campaign signs

- (a) may be placed off the travelled portion and improved shoulders of any highway provided that the signage is not erected on highway medians or affixed to traffic control devices or utility poles or trees or in any manner which obstructs the free passage or visibility of pedestrians or traffic;
- (b) must not be placed on the highway located
 - (i) adjacent to Lot A, VIP55047 known as the Municipal Grounds,
 - (ii) at the southwest corner of the intersection of Metchosin Road and Briarwood Lane.
- (c) must be removed within 4 days immediately following general voting day.

10. Removed, Detained, or Impounded

- (1) Any chattel, obstruction or vehicle removed, detained, or impounded may be recovered by the owner upon presenting proof of ownership, and upon payment in full of any fees, costs, and expenses which may be levied pursuant to the provisions of this bylaw to:
 - (a) the District's towing contractor or authorized agent in the case of a vehicle.
 - (b) Municipal Hall during regular business hours in the case of any chattel or obstruction.

FEES (2) The fees, costs, and expenses which shall be paid by the owner of the chattel, obstruction, or vehicle removed, detained or impounded pursuant to this Part shall be as designated in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
